## Del. Counsel Group to Take Part In Monthly Gallery Tour

On June 3, The Delaware Counsel Group will participate in a monthly art gallery tour sponsored by the Wilmington Arts Commission, Cityfest Inc. and the city of Wilmington's Office of Cultural Affairs. The galleries, including Delaware Counsel Group's office, which is located at 300 Martin Luther King Blvd. in Wilmington, are open from 5:30 to 8 p.m.

Delaware Counsel Group will display the mixed media works of Jane Quartarone, paintings by Leslie Keller and mixed media efforts by Sallie Ketcham, all of whom are members of the Delaware Center for the Contemporary Arts.

The Delaware Counsel Group's office space is located in one of the old manufacturing buildings along the Wilmington Riverfront. The building sits near train tracks that made it easy to facilitate the packing, transportation and manufacturing of goods during the early 1900s. The interior is a refurbished space with large open rooms, high ceilings, original steel doors and open-faced brick walls. The artwork of the three local-area artists is displayed prominently throughout the firm's public spaces. The displays rotate throughout the year with the art-

work of other members of the DCCA.

## Law School Children's Book Drive Generates Donations

The second annual READelaware book drive has generated nearly 1,200 new and gently used children's books to benefit the Christina School District's six After-School Learning Academies.

Widener University School of Law, the Delaware State Bar Association, Delaware Volunteer Legal Services and several Delaware law firms took part in the drive, which was held in conjunction with National Library Week last month.

READelaware is a nonprofit organization created in 2004 in memory of Rae Coats, an avid reader and the aunt of Eileen Cooper, a Widener University School of Law professor who directs the school's Legal Information Center. Cooper initiated the first book drive last year.

Widener Law anchored the book drive, which was expanded from last year to include collection points at the Community Service Building on 10th Street in Wilmington, and the Nemours Building on Orange Street in Wilmington. The DSBA, DVLS and area law firms provided drop boxes for employees to boost book donations.
